ADF POST DISCHARGE HEALTH ASSESSMENT

As of 1st July, 2014, all former serving personnel, including former service members of either the permanent or reserve forces, will be able to access a funded health assessment from their GP.

One of the key objectives of this assessment is to help GP's identify and diagnose the early onset of health problems among former serving ADF members.

Talk to your regular GP regarding this health assessment and let them know that you are a former serving ADF member and then book in at Reception for your assessment.

This Health Assessment will take approximately 1 hour. Advise Reception you are booking in for ADF Health Assessment, they will book you firstly with our Practice Nurse, then with your regular Doctor.

CVC PROGRAM

The Department of Veteran Affairs run a CVC Program for gold card holders who suffer from certain conditions. Your GP or sometimes DVA will identify you as suitable for this program. The aim of the CVC Program is to keep you well and out of hospital and at home, rather in a nursing home by having your care coordinated by our Practice Nurse and your regular GP.

Participants of this program will have contact with our Practice Nurse monthly, and your Doctor will do a CVC review at least every 3 months.
