Medicare changes to bulk billing 2020

Medicare is a government funded health insurance subsidy scheme, it is not a bulk billing scheme. Ocean Wave Medical presently choose to bulk bill Aged Pensioners, Children under 15 years, in addition Health Care Card holders from their second visit.

By bulk billing a Medical practice that chooses to accept the scheduled Medicare rebate as full payment for their services, known as 'bulk billing'. However, these rebates often do not cover the full cost of delivering a high-quality health service.

The Government's indexation of Medicare rebates has not kept pace with CPI (cost of living), which is placing unsustainable pressure on General Practice. As of 1st January 2020 more changes will occur to Medicare rebates for bulk billing, meaning Medicare will pay less to your Doctor to bulk bill you. These changes will mean that Medicare rebates will be equivalent to 2010 levels.

A number of fully private fees will be introduced in January 2020 namely for Iron Infusions, Venesections, Implanon, Mirena's, and procedures and wound care etc. Reception will have a full list of these private fees.

You may have noticed many medical centres on the Sunshine Coast are currently changing or will be changing as of 1.1.2020 from fully bulk billing to mixed or private billing to be able to sustain the ongoing costs.

Here at Ocean Wave Medical we are endeavouring to be able to keep offering bulk billing to eligible patients and will continue to review this and advise our patients if any changes will be introduced in the future.

What is a Care Plan, and who is eligible

You may be eligible for a Care Plan/GPMP if you have a chronic (or terminal) medical condition. A Chronic medical condition is one that has been (or is likely to be) present for six months or longer, for example, asthma, cancer, heart disease, diabetes, arthritis and stroke. However, these items are designed for patients who require a structured approach and to enable GPs to plan and coordinate the care of patients with complex conditions requiring ongoing care from a multidisciplinary care team. Your GP will determine whether a plan is appropriate for you. If you have complex care needs and require treatment from two or more other health care providers, your GP may suggest TCA as well. If a GPMP and TCA are prepared by your GP, you may be eligible for Medicare rebates for certain allied health services, up to 5 per calendar year.

There are 2 types of plans that can be prepared by your usual General Practitioner, a GPMP and a TCA. Medicare defines 'usual' as, means the GP, or a GP working in the medical practice, who has provided the majority of care to the patient over the previous 12 months and/or will be providing the majority of GP services to the patient over the next 12 months.

EARLY DETECTION OF SKIN CANCER

It's important to be familiar with

your skin and what is normal, so you can detect any abnormal changes.

If you notice anything unusual such as any changes in the shape, colour or size of a spot, or the sudden appearance of a new spot, it is important to visit your GP as soon as possible.





SUMMER PROTECTION TIPS

COVER UP: To protect yourself from the aging effects of the sun, you want to cover your head, your body, and your eyes as much as possible.

HATS: Hats are necessary in the sun. This might be the single best thing you can do to protect the sensitive skin of your face and neck-the same skin that is often exposed to the sun. Wide Brim Hats are best.

SUNGLASSES: Your eyes are sensitive to UV rays, and UVA and UVB rays both damage your eyes just like they damage your skin. To avoid cataracts and diminished vision, wear sunglasses that have 100% UVA and UVB protection. The tighter they fit and the more they wrap around the sides of your eyes (and don't let in light above or below them), the better.

SUNSCREEN: Use sunscreen with at least an SPF of 15 and broad UVA and UVB protection. The problem is, many sunscreen lotions also contain toxic chemicals and don't protect very well against UVA rays. Use a sunscreen with zinc oxide and titanium dioxide (that haven't been micronized) and no other active ingredients. It's tough to find, but these ingredients will provide decent UV coverage without many of the toxicities of other sunscreen chemicals.

WATER: Be sure to drink plenty of water and stay Hydrated

REDUCE ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION

With the festive season approaching, it is difficult to avoid the parties and the consumption of alcohol that comes with it. Here are some basic guidelines to keep your health in check when it comes to consuming drinks

<u>Standard drink</u>: a drink that contains approximately 10g of alcohol

You should drink no more than 2 standard drinks on any given day. The more **alcohol** you drink, the greater your risk of injury or disease over the course of your life. If you drink less than 2 standard drinks per day.



No safe level of drinking - While there is no safe level of drinking, the National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC) has developed some guidelines to help us understand the impact of drinking on our health, wellbeing and safety.

Harm: the undesirable impacts of drinking alcohol.

Immediate and short-term harms related to drinking alcohol may include hangovers, headaches, nausea, shakiness, vomiting, memory loss, falls and injury, assaults, car accidents, unplanned pregnancy and accidental death.

Long-term harms associated with regular drinking include cancer, cirrhosis of the liver, brain damage, memory loss and sexual dysfunction.

Other potential harms can include damage to relationships, problems at work or school, and legal and financial difficulties.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Raspberry & Coconut Bliss Balls (makes approx. 30)

1 cup frozen berries

6 fresh dates (seeds removed)

(10 dates if using dried dates*)

1½ cup desiccated coconut

1 cup nuts and seeds (e.g. cashews, almonds, sunflower seeds, pepitas)

1 tsp vanilla extract

Extra coconut for rolling

st if using dried dates, soak in water for 10mins or longer to rehydrate

Method:

1. Add all ingredients to food processer and blend until combined and smooth.

2. Using a teaspoon size of mixture, roll into a ball and coat in coconut. An alternative to

rolling, press into a lined slice tray and cut into 30 pieces

3. Store bliss balls in fridge for 1 week, or can be frozen

Variations – vary the flavour by using other frozen fruit e.g. mango *Recipe is Gluten Free
